


**Instructions**

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


## IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

1. Mere issue of Hall Ticket to the Candidate does not imply that his Candidature has been finally cleared by the TSLPRB. TSLPRB will take up verification of the eligibility conditions with reference to the original documents for those Candidates who are declared qualified in Final Written Examination. Candidates must note that their admission to the Tests / Exams is purely **Provisional**
2. Candidate shall wear masks all through their stay at the Examination Centre. Each Candidate must bring his own transparent Water-Bottle and Hand-Sanitizer. Social distancing shall be maintained
3. This Hall Ticket is valid only if the combined image of the Candidate's photograph and signature is legible (Taking of Print-Out on both sides of A4 sized paper on a Laser Printer is highly recommended). Further, a copy of the Candidate's passport photo has to be fastened at the designated place. Otherwise, Hall Ticket will not be accepted and Admission to Examination will be denied. 4. Candidates are advised to visit their Centre of Examination one day prior to the actual Date of Examination and make sure about their Examination Centre. Change of Examination Centre will not be entertained under any circumstances. No traveling expenses will be paid for the journey, if any performed, to take the Test
5. Candidates will be permitted into the Examination Hall one hour prior to the commencement of the examination. Candidates will not be allowed into the Examination Hall once the examination commences and will not be allowed to leave till the conclusion of the Examination. **Candidates will not be allowed into the Examination Hall, if they are late even by a minute**
6. 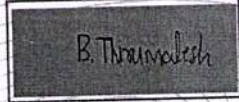

## Instructions to the Candidate

1. A printed copy of this Admit Card must be presented for verification along with the original (not photocopy or scanned copy) valid photo identification proof which is mentioned above. In case of poor quality of photo on ID proof, candidate MUST bring an additional recent valid photo ID also (For example: Passport, PAN Card, Voter ID, Aadhaar Card, Driving License).
2. Admit Card is considered to be valid only if both the photograph and signature are clear. To ensure this, print this admit card on A4 sized paper using laser printer, preferably in colour.
3. To facilitate the verification of their identity by the centre officials, candidates must report to the examination venue at least 90 minutes before the scheduled commencement of the examination.
4. Candidates will have to go through Photo-Registration and then be permitted to occupy their seats 60 minutes before the scheduled start of the examination. Candidates can login and start reading the instructions 20 minutes before start of the examination.
5. CANDIDATES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER EXAMINATION CENTRE 30 MINUTES AFTER START OF THE EXAM.
6. Candidates will NOT be permitted to leave the examination hall before the end of exam.
7. During the examination, a virtual scientific calculator will be available on the computer screen, which may be used for the numerical calculations.
8. Candidates should NOT bring any charts/tables/papers/books/sheets into the examination hall. Scribble pad will be provided for the rough work. Before using it, candidates must write their individual name and registration number. The candidate can possess ONLY one scribble pad at any point of time. Before taking the second scribble pad, if required, the first scribble pad MUST be returned to the invigilator. At the end of the examination, the remaining scribble pad must also be returned to the invigilator.
9. Personal calculators, any kind of watches, wallets, mobile phones or any other electronic/communication devices are STRICTLY PROHIBITED inside the examination hall. GATE authorities are not responsible for the safekeeping of candidate's personal belongings. During the examination, candidates may be checked for possession of any of the prohibited items. If the candidate is found to possess any of the prohibited items, candidate will be debarred from the examination and/or subjected to disciplinary action, which may include ban from appearing in future examinations.
10. Candidates must bring their own pen, pencil, transparent water bottle and pocket size hand sanitizer. Dear Candidate,

1. This has reference to your Online Application for the post of **Supervisor (S-1 Grade)-Fixed Term (Mechanical)** against our Employment Notification No. HR/SUP:01/2022 published in leading News Papers and hosted on GRSE's website [www.grse.in](http://www.grse.in). Based on the performance in the written test conducted on 18 Sep 2022, schedule and list of shortlisted candidates for Document verification and Practical (Trade) Test is hosted on GRSE's website [www.grse.in](http://www.grse.in) on 01 Oct 2022. You are shortlisted for the PRACTICAL (TRADE) TEST and you are advised to appear for the TRADE TEST at your own expense on the date, time and venue mentioned in the Admit Card.
2. TRADE TEST will be conducted on **Engineering / Workshop practices** as per the above schedule. Any request from candidates for re-scheduling or change of test centre will not be entertained.
3. **Admission to the Practical (Trade) Test / Call for Document Verification is strictly provisional. The mere fact that the Provisional Admit Card/ Call Letter has been issued does not imply that candidature of his / her has been accepted or he / she is selected for the post applied for.**
4. In case, at any time, it is found that you have furnished incorrect information in the online application and you are not meeting the eligibility criteria, your candidature will summarily be rejected forthwith.
